1. THE EVENT

The above event is held under the General Regulations of the Motor Sports Association (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA), the Regulations of the Association of Land Rover Clubs (ALRC) and these Supplementary Regulations.

The event is open to all full members of the organising Club and full members affiliated to the ALRC at the organisers discretion.

3. SIGNING ON

All competitors must produce, on request the following documentation:

Current Club Membership Card.

ALRC Vehicle Log Book.

Competitors will be identified by name.

Ineligible entries will be refused. The organisers decision is final.

The Entry Fee will be £20.00. The committee reserves the right to amend the entry fee.

4. VEHICLE REGULATIONS

All vehicles must comply with current regulations in the MSA Yearbook and the ALRC Hand Book.

Vehicle Classes for RTVT's / CCVT's will be as per the current ALRC Hand Book. Q Class vehicles are not allowed in CCVT's.

Multiple Entry of a vehicle is permitted.

5. CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS (Annual Trophies)

RTVT CHAMPIONSHIP:- Separate Trophies as per the Club newsletter

CCVT CHAMPIONSHIP:- Separate trophies as per the Club newsletter.

Championship points are awarded for each vehicle class in the trials as follows:-

1st – 6 points, 2nd – 5 points, 3rd – 4 points, 4th – 3 points, 5th – 2 points, 6th – 1 point.

*TO BE ELIGIBLE IN EITHER CHAMPIONSHIP A COMPETITOR MUST OFFICIATE AT ONE EVENT IN THAT PARTICULAR DISCIPLINE. E.g. Clerk of Course – 6 points, Assistant Clerk of Course – 4 points and Marshalling – 3 points. Should a member officiate for a second time due to no other member coming forward then they will awarded the points for a second time.

The above points are recorded in a table throughout the year culminating in the final position being known on the 31st December. Trophies for the appropriate class winners are presented at the Club's Annual Dinner.

6. EVENT TROPHIES

Trophies will be awarded in each vehicle class (subject to entry and if required) as follows:

Class minimum (4 vehicles) – 1st and 2nd ONLY.

5 vehicles and above – 1st, 2nd and 3rd.

Classes are subject to amalgamation on the day (dependent on entries).

7. EVENT TIMETABLE

Scrutineering opens at 8.30am and closes at 10.00am. Competitors should arrive by 9.30am.

Competitors not signed on by 9.30am may be excluded.

The running order will be given at the start but may be changed throughout the event. Failure to go when asked will incur a 12 point penalty.

Start signal will be verbal.

8. SCORES AND RESULTS

Results will be kept on a master score sheet held by the start marshal.

Provisional results will be announced as soon as is practical after the end of the event and confirmed as final results in the next Club newsletter.
